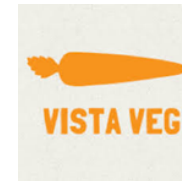

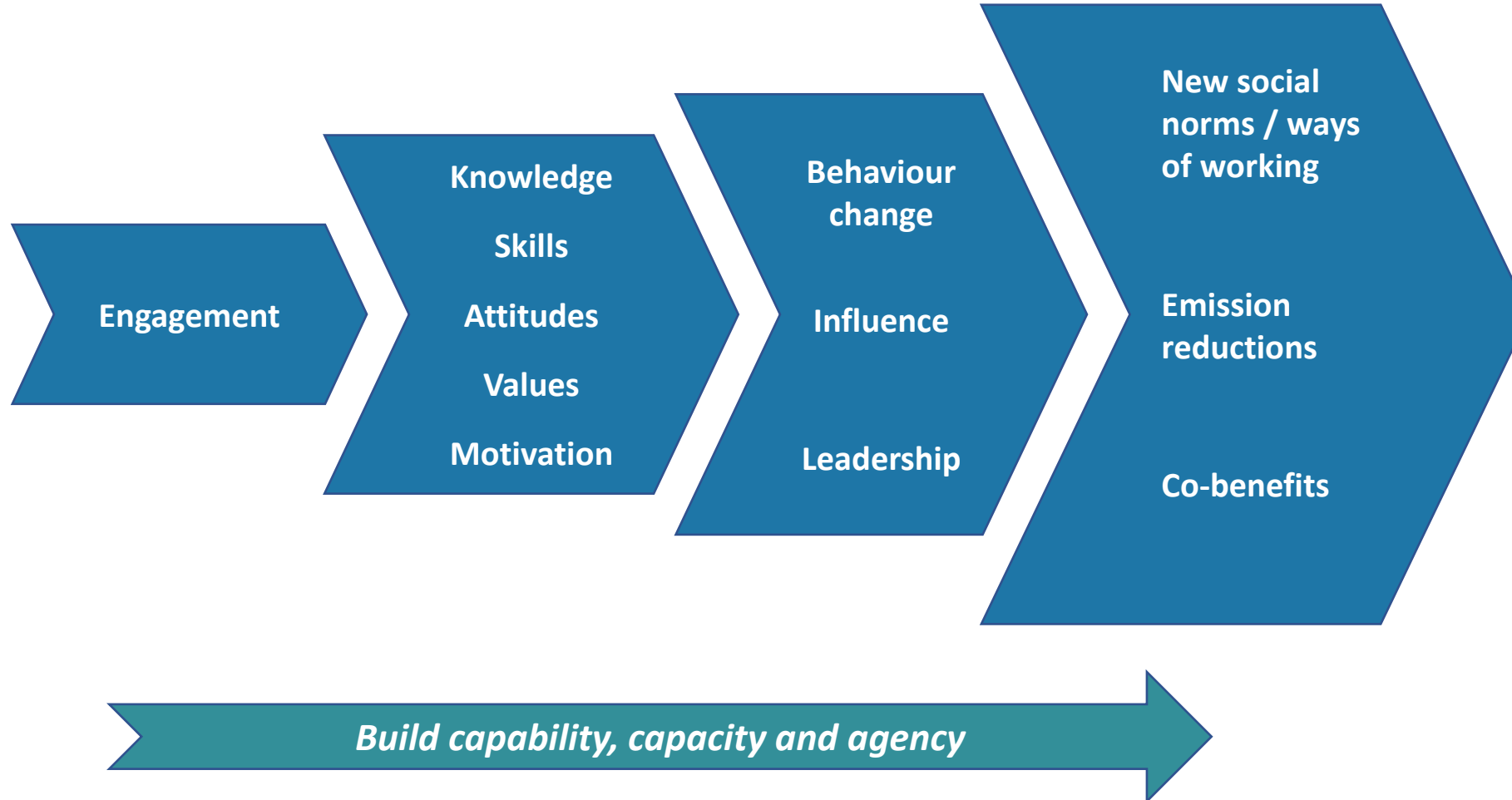

SUMMARY OF GREENHOUSE GAS EMISSIONS IN CUMBRIA AND TRAJECTORIES TOWARDS NET ZERO

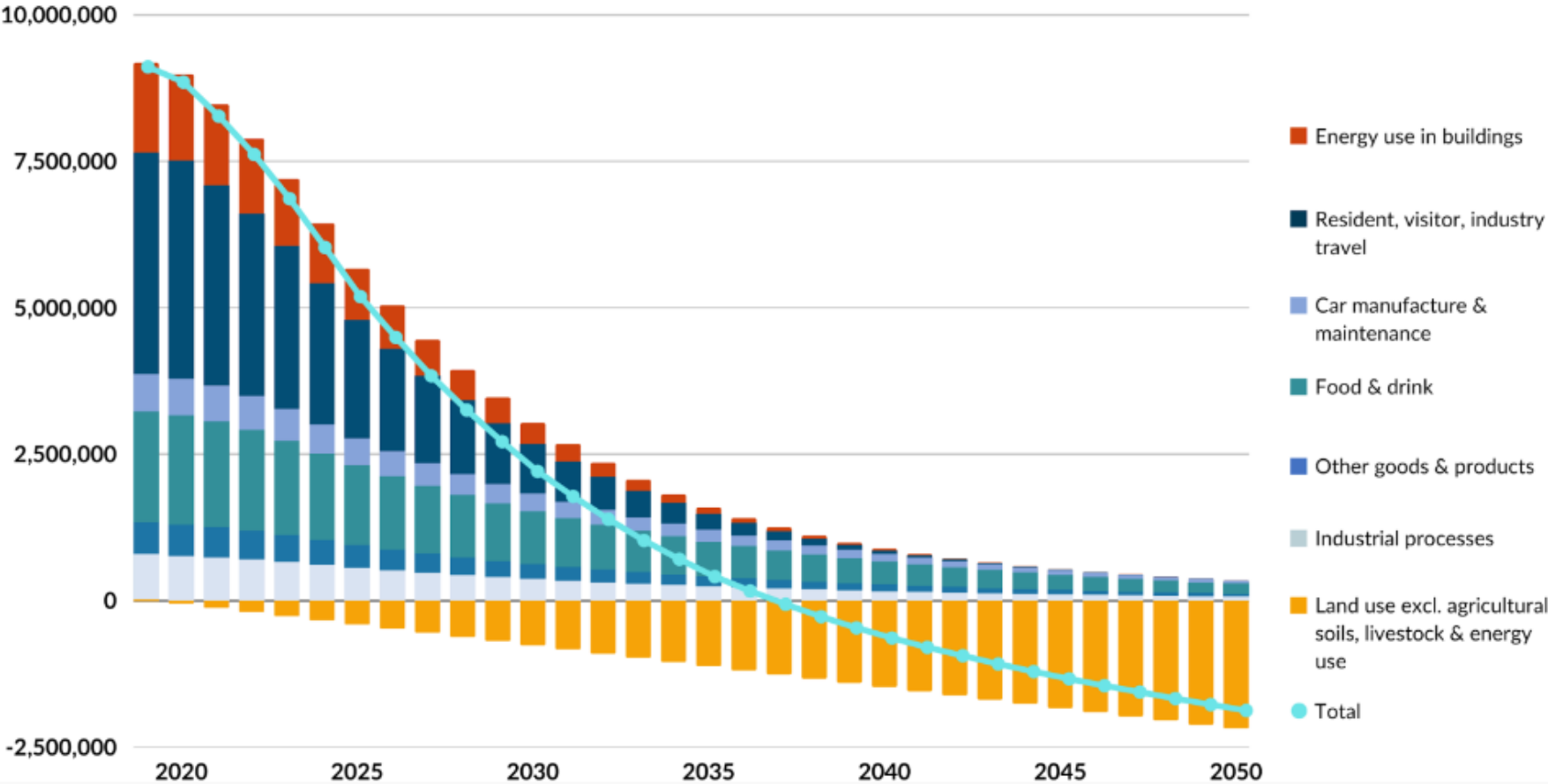

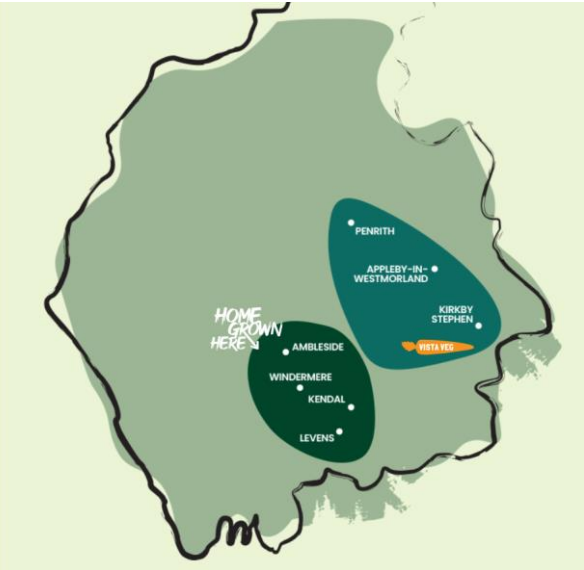
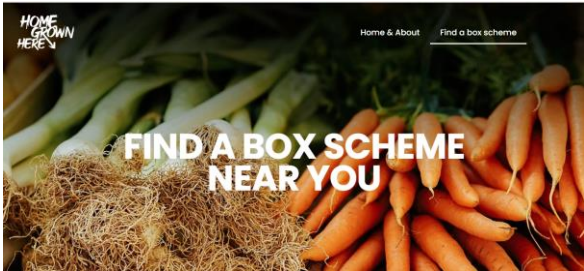
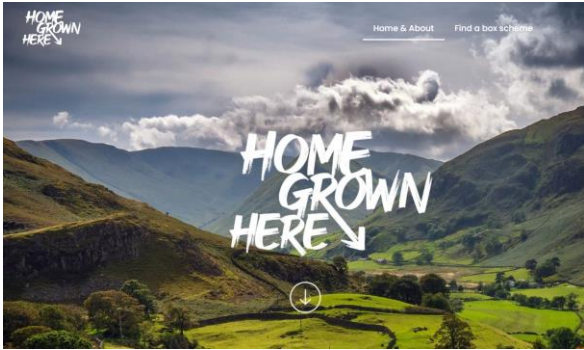
For projects that are:

 - Supporting a community benefit fund to fund local community projects.

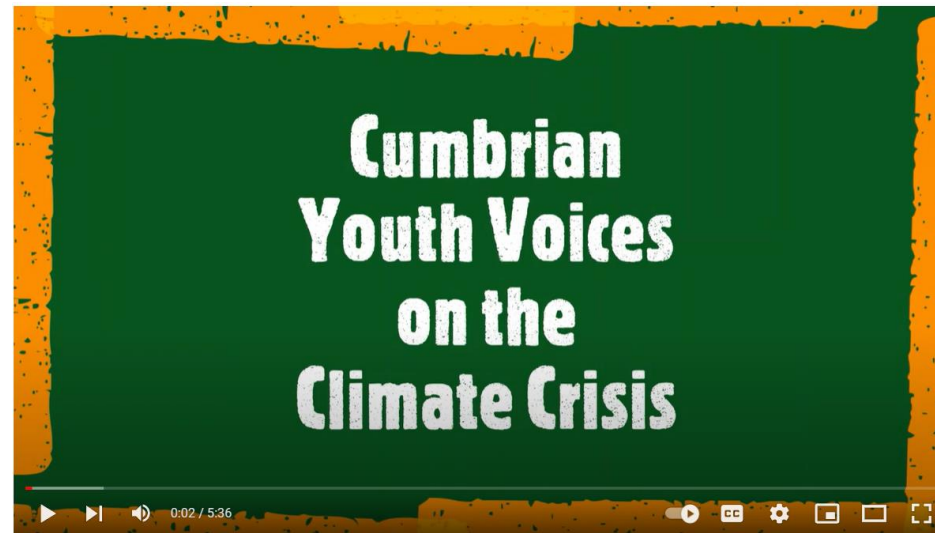
